H. With reference to your letter of the 14th January last, addressed to the Society's Liverpool Office, in regard to the steamer "AUTHOR", I beg to acquaint you that I am now in receipt of a communication from the Liverpool Surveyors in which they state the steamer is now laid up at their port for sale purposes, and will probably be broken up. The case has received consideration today, and in view of the Liverpool Surveyors' statement, and of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the 2nd Special Survey No.2 has now expired, I am directed to explain that it is the Committee's usual practice in such cases to require Owners to furnish an undertaking in regard to the overdue surveys.
