SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

In March last the Owners stated this vessel had been sold to Italian shipbreakers, and in a letter dated the 29th July the Trieste Surveyors stated they had been informed by the purchasers (Società Italiana Ernesto Breda of Venice) that the demolition of this vessel began on the 20th of that month, and on the 2nd August the Classing Committee decided to expunge her class and insert the record "Broken up".

It now appears, however, from Lloyd's Index that the vessel has not been broken up, but actually left Venice on the 6th November for Rotterdam under the name of "Ernesto".

The Trieste Surveyors, in reply to inquiry, confirm the above, and the case is again submitted to the Committee with a view to the record of "Broken up" being <sup>amended</sup> cancelled in the Register Book and the name of the vessel to remain without her previous class.
