Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 25th ultimo enclosing one received from Messrs. The Koninklijke Nederlandsche Stoomboot Maatschappij relative to the ex-German Steamer "TOTMES" now named "ST. ADBAN'S ABBEY", and in reply I have to say that a certificate for four years cannot be issued in this case until the survey for classification has been satisfactorily carried out.

I should add that the six-monthly certificate at present in force does not expire until the end of August, and as it would appear to be the Charterers' intention to have the survey for classification carried out on the vessel's arrival at Rotterdam about the end of September next, the Committee have, in the special circumstances, agreed to extend the present certificate until that time, and I enclose herewith a letter to this effect, which should be forwarded to Messrs. Koninklijke Nederlandsche Stoomboot Maatschappij.
