In connexion with the change of name of the steamer "TOTMES" to "ST. ALBANS ABBEY", I beg to acquaint you that this vessel was surveyed in February last at the request of the David Steamship Co. Ltd., by the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle with a view to the General Condition of the Hull and Machinery being ascertained, in accordance with an arrangement come to with the Ministry of Shipping in the case of the surrendered ex-Enemy Vessels which do not hold the Classification of this Society.

The Surveyors reported that judging from their inspection of the parts of the vessel and her Machinery that were examined, she appeared to be in a fit condition to run for a period of six months from the date of their survey, and the Owners have been furnished with a Certificate to this effect.
