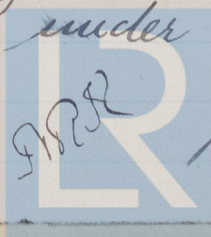
The Machinery boiler & screw shaft have been opened up & examined & satisfactorily reported upon.
