Particulars of Casualty

*Vessel is reported to have struck a rock near Platte Fougere Lighthouse, N. Guernsey, and to have capsized, being submerged at high water.*

*It is stated that the vessel is a total wreck, and that she has been abandoned to the Underwriters.*

*In reply to the usual casualty notice, the Owners agree to the customary record being made in the Register Book.*

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

**FORELAND.** — Guernsey, Feb. 20. — Steamer Foreland (286 tons net), Amsterdam for Guernsey, cargo coal, struck rock north of island at 10 o'clock this morning and is now in a dangerous position. Vessel may possibly get off at high water. Now proceeding to vessel. — Lloyd's Agent.

Guernsey, Feb. 20. — Steamer Foreland capsized over on starboard side. Now submerged at high water close to Platte Fougere lighthouse. Consider vessel and cargo total loss. Master and crew landed safely. — Lloyd's Agent.

**FORELAND.** — Guernsey, Feb. 21. — Steamer Foreland: Total wreck. Owners have abandoned vessel to underwriters.
