The class of this vessel is subject to the sternframe, repaired by electric welding in May 1922, and the rudder repaired by the same process in July 1923, being specially examined at the next dry docking.

Cast
Steel.

The Kobe Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated, 1 stem plate on each side doubled where found fractured, minor repairs effected, and the sternframe and rudder examined where welded and found efficient.

Bulwarks have now been fitted forward.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 2,27, subject as above, as recommended.
