First entry.

It is submitted that in forwarding the Classification Certificate of this vessel to the Newcastle Surveyors they should be requested to retain them in their possession until they have obtained <sup>from the Builders</sup> the written consent of the Owner to the mission of sailing <sup>from the</sup> holds, <sup>except under the hatchways and over the bulks.</sup>

The Newcastle Surveyors should at the same time be informed that knowing the Committee's requirement in this matter they should <sup>have</sup> obtained and forwarded the document in question along with their first entry report, and should not have accepted as sufficient for the purpose the Builders letter of the 12<sup>th</sup> inst.
