I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th instant confirming the interview which I had the pleasure of having with Mr. Sanderson of your Firm of Consulting Engineers regarding the completion of the 2nd Special Survey No.2 of the steamer "KEMMEL".

I do not think I need repeat the circumstances which led the Committee to take the action they did, this having been explained to Mr. Sanderson, but the Committee desire me to point out that when issuing the Interim Certificate in November last it was anticipated that the vessel would return by the expiration of the year of grace and have been submitted for the completion of the survey before the year of grace expired.

In the special circumstances I have cabled the Society's New York Office to carry out a general examination now required by the Committee on the hull and machinery, and have informed them that any repairs which may be found necessary consequent upon this examination must be carried out, and if possible any item of the Special
