We beg to refer to your letter of the 9th instant, reference "S", relative to the Second Special Survey No.2 of the s.s. "KEMMEL", and to the interview which our Consultant Engineers, Messrs. Henry Sanderson & Co. had with you this morning.

We understand that Mr. Sanderson explained the position fully to you and especially that the vessel was drydocked and examined in Cardiff as recently as November 1933.

We have no objection to a general inspection by your New York Surveyor, but we do trust that this will not mean expending money abroad or delay to the ship.

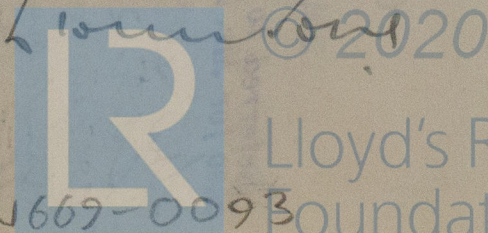
There is a freight offering from Cuba with the 31st March cancelling, and if no delay takes place the "KEMMEL" is in a suitable position for the freight, inasmuch as we expect her to complete discharge by 19th March and arrive at Cuba about 28th March.
