Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 24th ultimo respecting the completion of the Second Special Survey No.2 of the steamer "KENNEL", and with regard thereto beg to inform you that the Committee have had your application for permission to defer the completion of this survey until the vessel's return to this side, under consideration at their meeting to-day.

With regard thereto I am directed to inform you that the Committee are surprised to learn of the present intended commitments of the vessel, which, if carried out, would not permit of her return to this side until May, when it is noted you propose to complete the survey.

As you are aware, the year of grace allowed for the completion of the survey in question expired at the end of last month, and when the vessel was under survey at Cardiff in November last your Superintendent requested to be furnished with an interim certificate to enable her to make a voyage of about three months' duration to Spain, the River Plate, and return to U.K. or Continent. granted, as it was understood that the ship would return direct from the River Plate, which would have enabled her to have arrived in this Country by the end of February for completion of survey.

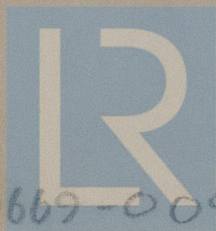
