11985 - PACIFIC - (Union Ironworks Co. No.119) The first entry report on this vessel has received the consideration of the Committee, and the vessel has been classed 100.A.1, and assigned notations A. & C.P.,* L.M.C., fitted for oil fuel 11,15, F.P. above 150^oF. I shall be glad if you will state the dates of the examination during construction of the various parts of the main steam turbine, and forward certificates of the tests of all the shafts, some of which we proposed when submitted to be of high tensile strength.
