

WIRELESS SERVICE TO SHIPS AT SEA.

Messages for transmission to ships at sea are accepted at any of the above Offices, where full particulars can be obtained, and at Radio Gram Stations in the United Kingdom.

NOTE: In addresses consisting of a name prefixed to the word "REGISTERED" or "ABBREVIATED ADDRESS," or where a telegram is addressed to houses and/or offices whose name is also given, the word "CARE" (as) or some equivalent expression must be inserted after the name given times saved and after accuracy is secured by the Public handing in their telegrams direct to the Company's Stations as above, while Telegrams for this Company's system are also received at all Postal Telegraph Offices, but should be marked "VIA EASTERN" or "VIA IMPERIAL" if intended for transmission by cable, or "VIA MARCONI" or "VIA WIRELESS" if intended for transmission by wireless.
