Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Steamer "TIGHNAMARA", I beg to remind you that the 2nd Special Survey No.2 prescribed in the Society's Rules has been partly held as regards the hull of the vessel by the examination of the bottom and rudder in drydock and the examination of the lower hold with ceiling lifted. The Special Survey of the machinery has been carried out but the Annual Boiler Survey became due at the end of October last.

In the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know, for the information of the Committee, when and at what port it will best suit your convenience to have the Special Survey of the hull completed and the Boiler Survey carried out.
