I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have assigned to her a Freeboard, as set forth at foot, and a letter has been addressed to the ~~Builder~~ ^{Owner} ~~them~~ ^{him} informing to that effect, and request you will let me know on the form of report of verification (Rpt. 12) when the Freeboard is marked on the vessel's sides, in order that a certificate thereof may be issued and a record made in the Register Book.

It is desirable you should at the same time survey the vessel in the usual way, if opportunity is afforded for such survey, and transmit a report to the Committee accordingly.

MAXIMUM LOAD-LINE in fresh water..... **2 1/2** inches above the centre of the disc.

" " in Indian Seas in Summer **---** inches above the centre of the disc.

" " in Summer the centre of the disc.

" " in Winter **---** inches below the centre of the disc.

" " in Winter, North Atlantic **---** inches below the centre of the disc.

Top of statutory deck line above ~~wood~~ ^{wood} upper deck at side..... **1** ins

The same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book.
