With reference to the plan, handed in at this Office by your Representative, Mr. Hartnoll, showing the alterations proposed to be effected to the Steel Screw Yacht "TIGHNAMARA" with a view to converting her into a cargo carrying vessel for service between London & Boulogne, I have pleasure in stating that provided the vessel be submitted to the Special Survey No. 3 due in June 1918, and the alterations be carried out as shown and amended on the plan and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the vessel could be recommended to the Committee for the Class A-, "For Service between London & Boulogne", subject to the freeboards to be assigned by the Committee, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification and recorded in the Register Book.

I shall be glad if you will let me know when and at what port the vessel will be submitted for survey and the proposed alterations effected, in order that the Society's Surveyors may be informed in regard to the case.
