I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 26th instant respecting the "CLAN MACINTOSH", from which I note that the work of demolition of this vessel has not yet been commenced.

As the vessel appears to have been lying off Messrs. Douglas & Ramsey's Works now since February last, and the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Second Special Survey No.3 expires at the end of the present month, the Committee, who have had the matter under discussion at their meeting to-day, have decided to record against the vessel's name in the Register Book "In Port 7.32 - To be broken up", and the vessel's class will therefore be automatically expunged from the Register Book.
