H. I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Havre recommended last month that the steamer "CLAN MACINTOSH" should be further examined and permanently repaired on account of having sustained damage to the bridge deck stringer plate through heavy weather.

The Owners state however that she is discharging at Liverpool, but that no repairs will be effected at that port, and that she will proceed to Glasgow where she will be delivered to a firm of shipbreakers.

In the circumstances I shall be glad to learn in due course the name and address of the purchasers and you will be so good as to advise me immediately the work of demolition has been commenced.
