Dear Mr. Scott,

I enclose you an extract regarding the loss of the "Chuky" from the "Bulletin," a monthly production which I regularly receive from the Standard Shipping Company, which as you know is the Standard Oil Company of New Jersey. We are referring to this loss in this week's number. I have discussed the loss with a number of underwriters and they are anxious to secure the names of all the vessels built on this system, as there is no notation in Lloyd's Register to indicate the system. I should feel obliged if you could supply me with such a list. You will remember that some years ago when the sister ship "Toco" was strengthened in New York I saw you on the matter, as particulars were sent us at the time which we did not publish. These vessels are I believe built on the Foster King system.
