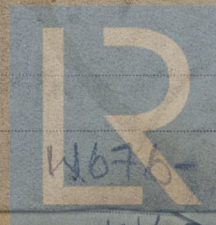
Date of Casualty *22nd February 1930*

Précis of particulars of Casualty

This steamer is reported to have stranded near Cape Inuboye on 22nd February, and subsequently to have broken in two and become a total loss.

A casualty notice was sent to the Owners on 2nd April.

In a letter dated 3rd May the Kobe Surveyors state they are informed by the Owners that the vessel was wrecked on 22nd February and abandoned by all concerned.
