CERTIFICATE FOR THE CARRIAGE OF CARGO OIL IN BULK.

This is to Certify that

Y. Jo,

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners survey the Deep Tank of the T.S.S. "ALABAMA MARU", 9617 tons gross of Ooske whilst the vessel lay afloat at this port.

The Deep Tank was tested on the 16th. October 1929 by a head of water to the top of the sounding pipes on weather deck, and upon examination, the boundary bulkheads, tank top, hatches, ventilators and other connections were found sound and tight.

The Double Bottom Tank in way of this Deep Tank was tested on the 24th. October 1929, by a head of oil fuel to the top of the air pipes on the weather deck and found sound and tight.

The Deep Tank is considered fit to receive a shipment of Cargo oil in bulk for the contemplated voyage subject to examination for cleanliness before loading.
