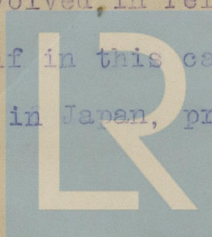
With reference to your letter of the 26th Nov. last, accompanying the Certificate of Class of the Twin Screw Sr. "Alabama Maru", I regret to state that owing to an error on the First Entry Report, the Registered Breadth given on the certificate requires correcting.

The Registered Breadth is 61.0 feet, kindly have same corrected on enclosed certificate, and also on First Entry Report.

I further regret that the error originally occurred on the First Entry Report of the T. S. S. "Arizona Maru", & shall be glad if you will have same also corrected.

Regarding the Certificate of Class of the latter vessel, enquiries have been made with a view of having same corrected, if necessary.

Probably some time will be required before this certificate can be obtained, so in view of this, & also owing to the length of ~~the~~ time involved in referring it back for correction, I wish to know, if in this case, it will be in order to make the correction in Japan, provided, of course,
