the freeboard marks provisionally assigned by Lloyd's Register of Shipping. The marks were found correct as follows:

Statutory deck line $2\frac{1}{2}$ " above the wood upper deck at side.

Centre of disc. $3' 9"$ below the statutory deck line.

Load line in fresh water $5\frac{1}{2}"$ above the centre of the disc.

" " Indian summer $4\frac{1}{2}"$ " " " " "

" " Summer - at the centre of the disc.

" " Winter. $5"$ below the centre of the disc.

Load line in Winter North Atlantic $7\frac{1}{2}"$ below the centre of the disc.
