The class is subject to six indented bow plates being repaired at the Owners' convenience, to the outer plates, repaired by electric welding 3,32, being specially examined at the next dry docking and to one length of retested chain cable being placed on board.

The Newcastle Surveyors now report a length of chain cable replaced on board after being repaired and retested.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey subject as above, except as regards the length of chain cable.
