Précis of particulars of Casualty

This vessel stranded and sank near Daio Saki, Miye-ken, on the 10th February, 1935.

It was found upon examination that she had sustained such heavy damage that it was stated salvage was hopeless, & she was abandoned.

In reply to a special casualty letter the Owners state that there are no prospects of salvage on account of the serious damage to the hull of the vessel & she has already been abandoned.

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

KOYASAN MARU. Kobe, Feb. 12. Japanese motor vessel Koyasan Maru badly ashore off Daio Saki, Miye Ken, Feb. 10. Crew taken off.

London, Feb. 12. The following cable has been received from Tokio, timed 12.26 p.m. to-day: Motor vessel Koyasan Maru, full cargo of pig iron, stranded and sank near Daio Saki at noon Feb. 10. Salvage vessel arrived this morning.

KOYASAN MARU. London, Feb. 19.

The following cable has been received from Tokio, dispatched at 3.36 p.m., Feb. 19: Motor vessel Koyasan Maru: Upon examination found sustained heavy damages to the extent not worth cost of refloating, therefore salvage operations have been stopped. (See issue of Feb. 13.)

KOYASAN MARU. London, Apr. 9.

In reply to inquiry with reference to motor vessel Koyasan Maru, which stranded and sank near Daio Saki in February, Lloyd's Agents at Kobe write under date of Mar. 15: The owners state that the salvage of the Koyasan Maru was hopeless, and the vessel has been abandoned. 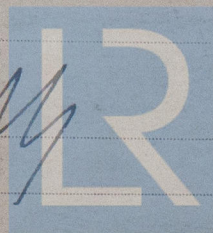
