With reference to your letter of the 7th instant regarding the steamer "KENILWORTH CASTLE", we have again been in communication with the representative of the Union Castle Mail S.S. Co.Ltd., who are responsible for the delivery of the vessel at Blyth. It has been decided that we shall make a general examination of the vessel which shall include an internal examination of such boilers as will be used for the voyage and the adjusting of the safety valves.
