Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant, with enclosures, regarding the survey carried out by you on the steamer "KENILWORTH CASTLE" for the extension of the Freeboard Certificate until the 31st May, 1936.

The Certificates have been endorsed in this Office for this extension and are returned herewith for issue to the ship.

With reference to your statement that you have charged a fee of £5 for the Freeboard Renewal Survey, I have to point out that in accordance with Footnote 6 to the Schedule of fees in Statutory Rules and Orders, 1934, No. 184, when for special reasons a Certificate is issued or renewed for a period not exceeding twelve months, one half of the fee appropriate to a full survey will be charged. The fee for the Freeboard Survey in this case should therefore be £2.10.0 and I have to request that you will make the necessary amendment.
