I beg to enclose the Affidavit which I have made in connection with the case of the steamer "TRECII", the document being the draft received today from Messrs Banaz & Rusko, Lloyd's Agents, Dubrovnik, and I am also enclosing a copy which I have made.

In order that the position may be clear to you in regard to paragraphs 5 & 6, I am sending herewith copies of the correspondence that passed between Lloyd's Agents and myself respecting the matter. Then, in order that there should be no doubt as to the legality of the statement in para.6, I have consulted Dr. Ulikse Stanger, a prominent Lawyer in Split, who has advised me that the declaration as it stands is true in the light of my letter of the 9th. ultimo addressed to Mr. Rusko, which, I understand, was forwarded to the Salvage Association.
