Dear Sir,

With reference to previous correspondence which has passed between us respecting the case of the steamer "TREC I", I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a further letter from the Salvage Association stating that their Solicitors have now been able to arrange with their opponents that an affidavit by you would be accepted as evidence and thus obviate the necessity of your coming to London.

It appears that the draft of the affidavit has already been forwarded by the Salvage Association through their Agents at Dubrovnik, and it is being pointed out to the Salvage Association that this affidavit should have been forwarded through this Office.

In the circumstances it is desired that you should return the affidavit here instead of forwarding it direct to the Salvage Association in order that it may be perused.
