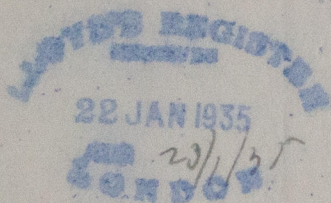

and have to confirm sending the following reply:-

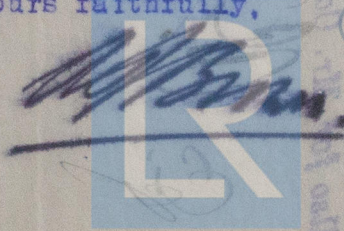
