Dear Sir,

I beg to acquaint you that Mr. Brown, the Society's Surveyor at Split, has forwarded to this Office a letter dated the 11th instant received from Lloyd's Agents at Dubrovnik, making enquiry on your behalf relative to the steamer "TRECİ", and with regard thereto I think it well to inform you that in the case of a vessel examined afloat after grounding it is the usual practice, whether damage be found or not, for the Society's Surveyors to recommend the vessel to be examined in drydock at the first convenient opportunity.

In this case the Surveyor states that he made the recommendation as a matter of form and had no reason to suspect the seaworthiness of the vessel at the time.
