Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.3 which became due at the end of September 1933 on the steamer "FOTINI CARRAS", I have to acquaint you that the Committee recently agreed to this vessel proceeding to the Black Sea to load a non-perishable cargo for Bona, Oran or Algiers and thence to a West Italian port, where it is understood she is to be broken up, subject to a satisfactory General Examination by the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus, where the vessel was laid up, before sailing.

A satisfactory General Examination has been held at Piraeus and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will keep the case in mind and advise me as soon as the work of demolition is commenced.
