CLASSIFICATION OF VESSELS LAID UP.

With reference to the list of vessels laid up under an undertaking, I think it well to acquaint you that the Committee recently agreed to the s.s. "POTINI CARRAS" (No. 76297 in the Register Book) proceeding to the Black Sea to load a cargo for Italy, where it was understood she was to be broken up, subject to a satisfactory examination by the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus before she sailed.

The Piraeus Surveyors' report has now come to hand, from which it is seen that the vessel is in fit condition to retain her class for such a voyage.

The necessary footnote is being added to the list in this Office of vessels laid up under an undertaking.
