REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH

Nature of Survey

The class is subject to the H Column being examined & the Centre furnace of the port boiler examined or renewed before the vessel sails; to some slight repairs being effected & to the Douhey Boiler not being used.

The Committee have agreed to the vessel making a Black Sea voyage to discharge in Italy & then being broken up, subject to a general examination.

General examination now made Boiler pressure reduced to both a temporary repair effected to the port boiler Centre furnace & other minor repairs effected.

It is submitted action be referred.
