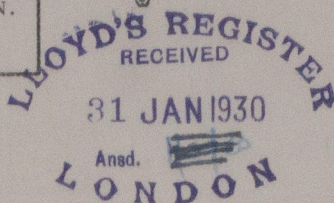

I am directed by the Board of Trade to inform you that they have requested their Solicitor to take the necessary steps for holding a Formal Investigation into the circumstances attending the loss of the s.s. "Radyr", of Cardiff, Official Number 142,447. The vessel sailed from Cardiff with a cargo of coal and a crew of 21, bound for Bordeaux, and is believed to have foundered with all hands on the 7th December, 1929, off Hartland Point, Bristol Channel.
