

Official Enquiry into loss of the s.s. "RADYR".

Mr. Cheetham, the Society's Principal Surveyor for the Bristol Channel Ports, has forwarded a Report on the above Enquiry recently held at Cardiff.

The vessel was lost with all hands when on a voyage from Cardiff to Bordeaux in December 1929.

A wireless message from the ship stated that the hatches were stove in, and in consequence of this considerable evidence was given in regard to certain hatches which were washed ashore, and the character of the material from which they were constructed.

Evidence was also given concerning the stowage of the coal cargo.

There is nothing in the Surveyor's report which calls for special comment.
