Précis of particulars of Casualty

This steamer arrived at Gijon with a heavy list on 30th December 1925 and sank.

Action has been deferred from time to time pending the result of salvage operations.

On 27th September Lloyd's Agent at Gijon reported that the vessel had not yet been refloated, although many attempts had been made, but the Owner intended to continue the work.

No later reports have been published.

9th December 1926

The Owner now states that the vessel is considered definitely lost; she is taking the necessary steps to have her broken up in order to obtain the material.

COVADONGA. — London, Oct. 4. — In reply to inquiry re Spanish steamer Covadonga, which arrived at Gijon at the end of last December with a heavy list to port and sank in deep water, Lloyd's Agent at Gijon writes under date of Sept. 24:—The Covadonga has not yet been refloated, although many attempts have been made; the owner intends to continue the work.

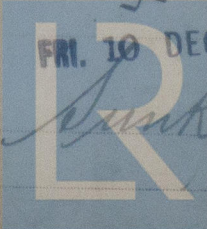
