The class is subject to a leak on the starboard side of No.2 tank being dealt with, and the tank being permanently repaired.

The 2nd S.S.No.2 will become due 4,27, and on the 1st instant the Owners were informed that the Committee must require the vessel to be submitted to the special survey within 2 months as recommended by the Antwerp Surveyors in March last.

The Genoa Surveyors now report damage sustained to steering gear and deck fittings through encountering heavy weather.

Partial repairs have been effected and the Surveyors recommend that permanent repairs be completed at Rotterdam, to which port the vessel is proceeding and that ^{RUDDER} the stuffing box _^ on the poop be overhauled at the first convenient opportunity.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Rotterdam Surveyors informed of the Surveyors' recommendation.
