The plans of boilers and shafting have previously been dealt with in the Secretary's letters of 25th August, 1921 and 29th August, 1921 respectively.

Plans of the pumping arrangements have now been forwarded by the Rotterdam Surveyors for consideration.

The pumping arrangements as shewn on plan meet the requirements of the Rules.

It is submitted that provided the working parts of the engines be opened out and examined, and be found in good order and safe working condition, and in accordance with the Rules; the pumping arrangements be as shewn on plan and otherwise in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, and the remaining requirements contained in Secretary's letters of 25th August and 29th August, 1921 respectively, the engines and boilers of this vessel might be accepted for the original working pressure of 13 kilogrammes per sq.cm. (say 185 lbs.per sq.in.) and a notation of LMC (with date) without the distinguishing mark ✕ be assigned.
