Dear Sirs,

With reference to the plan of the Deep Tank for the S.S. "OLDEKERK" ex "SESOSTRIS" No. 71898 in Register Book, shewing proposed strengthening so that the tank could be utilized for the carriage of vegetable oil in bulk, handed in to-day by your representatives, I have to state that provided the arrangements and alterations be carried out as shown and amended in the plan and to the Surveyor's satisfaction, the same will be approved.

The tank should be tested as required by Section 49 of the Rules and the remaining requirements of this Section in far as applicable including sparring or lining & gutterways etc. to be complied with.

A suitable notation regarding the carriage of vegetable oil in the deep tank will be made in the Register Book.

The arrangements have been discussed in this Office with Mr. Eikelboom the Owners superintendent and Messrs. van der Berg & S.M.H. Chambers representing your firm by whom was pointed out that the tank would at times be only partly filled
