S.S. "AMMON"

This vessel was surveyed at London  
13/7/21 and a seaworthy certificate issued for a voyage to  
Rotterdam.

She is owned by the Vereenigde  
Nederlandsche Scheepvaartmaatschappij who intend submitting  
her for classification survey at Rotterdam.

The vessel was built in 1915 by Flensburger  
Schiffsb. Ges. and appears to be a sister vessel to the S.S.  
"AMMON" the scantlings of which have been examined in this  
office and found eligible for the class 100A "shelter deck"  
with a suitable addition to the freeboard to compensate for the  
deficiencies in certain scantlings.

No plans are available showing the  
structure of the vessel, but a copy of the sheet of scantlings  
for the S.S. "AMMON" should be forwarded to the Society's  
Surveyors at Rotterdam for their information and guidance.

It is submitted they should be instructed  
to carry out the survey for classification in accordance with  
section 48 of the Rules.

The scantlings will require to be ascertained  
from the vessel and reported on First Entry Report Forms.

The Surveyors should satisfy themselves  
regarding the construction of the rudder, tunnel, watertight  
bulkheads, strengthening of the bottom forward, and  
arrangements to prevent panting.
