Ex-German Steamer "SESOSTRIS"

Mr. Edmonds representing Mr. Rogers of Messrs. Harris & Dixon called at this Office today, and requested to be informed of the requirements for the classification of this vessel.

Mr. Rogers had previously left a copy of the midship section of the vessel.

Mr. Edmonds was informed that this vessel appeared to be a sister vessel to the S.S. "AMMON", and the scantlings of this vessel had been examined and it was found she was eligible for the class 100A "Shelter Deck" for the suitable addition to the freeboard to compensate for the deficiencies in certain scantlings.

He was also informed that to obtain the Figure 1 the equipment would require to be found in order, and the Certificates for the anchor and cables produced.

He was informed of the increase to freeboard which would probably be necessary for the ship's classification.

The midship section was handed to Mr. Edmonds.
