Précis of particulars of Casualty

The 2nd Special Survey N°2 which became due in June, 1933, has been partly held.

The vessel was recently sold to Italian purchasers, following a general examination by the Newcastle Surveyors, arrived at Venice on the 19th December, to be broken up.

The Trieste Surveyors now state, in a letter dated 23rd January, they are informed by the Società Anonima Italiana Ernesto Breda that the work of demolition began at Mestre on the 8th January.
