Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to the Second Special Survey No. 2 which became due at the end of June, 1933, and has been partly held, on the steamer "CAPE COMORIN", I have to acquaint you that following a satisfactory General Examination at Newcastle in October last, the Committee agreed to this vessel loading a coal cargo from the Continent to an Italian port thereafter to be broken up, and, as it would appear from the Shipping Papers that this vessel arrived at Venice on the 19th ultimo, I shall be glad if you will keep the case in mind and advise me immediately the work of demolition <sup>is</sup> commenced.
