Précis of particulars of Casualty This vessel is reported to

have foundered in thirty fathoms  
off the east coast of Iceland  
after having struck a rock  
during a fog north of Eley, 16th Sept.No reply has been  
received to the usual casualty notice  
sent on the 19th October.

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

WALPOLE.—Reykjavik, Sept. 17.—Steam  
trawler Walpole foundered after having  
grounded during a fog on the east coast.  
Crew saved.London, Sept. 17. — The  
following cable has been received from  
Iceland, Sept. 17: Steam trawler Wal-  
pole stranded last night at one o'clock  
on Gerpir, north of Eley, east coast.  
Vessel hit the rock, but became loose,  
but on the way to Eskifjörður she filled  
from heavy leakage after about thirty  
minutes and sank at thirty fathoms  
depth. All crew saved in boats.

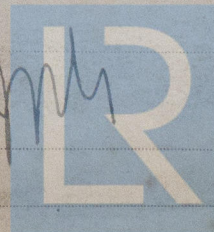
