The Special Survey No. 3 which became due in December, 1933, has been partly held. Proposals to postpone completion have been agreed to from time to time, in view of Modified Special Surveys being held by the Owners; & after a further examination at Rotterdam in September, 1935 the Committee agreed to the class being extended until the end of April, 1936.

The Owners now state, in a letter dated 4th May, that the vessel has been sold to Mr. Okada Seiichi, of Osaka, for breaking up purposes, & was handed over on the 2nd May (According to Lloyd's Index, the vessel arrived at Osaka on the 29th April).
