Dear Sir,

In reply to your classing letter of the 18th instant regarding the steamer "PALUDINA" I beg most respectfully to state that it is understood that "the internal examination and testing of some oil fuel compartments" was left over as a completion of the modified special survey held at Palermo.

With regard to this I beg to state that at the time of the modified special survey at this port the forward deep-tank, bunkers and fuel doublebottom tanks were full of oil and could not be examined internally but upon ^{ex}ternal examination all bulkheads were found tight.

No further arrangements have been made in the matter.
