A. With reference to the survey which has been held on the Twin Steel Screw Steamer "OHIO" at Bremen, with a view to the vessel being classed with this Society, I have to inform you that the reports have now been received from the Society's Surveyor at Bremen on the case, and it has been decided that an inclusive fee of £300 for the survey held on the hull and machinery of this vessel should be charged. An account has accordingly been rendered to Messrs. The Royal Mail Steam Packet Co., the Owners of the vessel, which has to-day been paid.

Of the total fee, £25 has been credited to your Port, in accordance with the intimation made in a letter, dated the 29th ultimo, addressed to this Office by Mr. Bahr. Perhaps, therefore, you will kindly see that the necessary entries are passed through your Rough Fee Book and Debit Book in the usual way.
