A. With reference to your Report No.637 on the Twin Steel Screw Steamer "OHIO", I have to inform you that it has been decided that an inclusive fee of £300 should be charged for the survey held on the hull and machinery of this vessel for classification, and an account has been rendered accordingly to Messrs. The Royal Mail Steam Packet Co., the Owners of the vessel, which has now been paid.


Of the total fee, £275 has been credited to your port, £195 having been allocated for the survey of the hull, £80 for the survey of the machinery, and the balance of £25 has been credited to the Hamburg Office in accordance with the request made by Mr. Dykes, the Society's Principal Surveyor in Germany, and referred to in your letter of the 29th ultimo. Perhaps, therefore, you will kindly see that the necessary entries are passed through your Rough Fee Book and Debit Book in the usual way.

I may add that the certificates are to-day being forwarded to the Owners.
