As requested in your letter of the 7th ultimo, I left London on Saturday the 17th ultimo for Bremen, for the purpose of joining Mr. Bahr, the Society's local Surveyor, in the survey of the Royal Mail Steam Packet Co's Steamer "OHIO", in drydock at Bremerhaven.

I arrived at Bremen on Sunday the 18th ultimo. On Monday the 19th ultimo we joined the steamer then lying afloat in the River Weser, off the Builders' Yard, Bremen, and proceeded to the dry dock at Bremerhaven.

On Tuesday the 20th, and following dates, an examination was made of the bottom and rudder etc. For particulars of survey please see copy of report attached.

I found the bottom well faired, and the workmanship and finish good.

On Monday the 26th ultimo, at the request of the Owners' representative, I proceeded in company with Mr. Bahr, on board the vessel from Bremerhaven to Hamburg and witnessed the steam trials of the main engines, also the trials of the auxiliary engines and other fittings, with very satisfactory results.

On Tuesday the 27th ultimo, I visited the Society's local Office at Hamburg, and had a short interview with
